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10                           TROY WOLLMAN,  
11           called as a witness, having been first duly sworn, testified  
12           as follows:

13                           EXAMINATION

14           BY MR. ROLLER:

15           Q   First off I suppose you think I have no clue so I  
16               figure I'll start out with a little clue. Did you kill

5   A   Yes.

6   Q   Or ChrisRoller.com. What portion of this did I tell

7       you -- we -- I told you about everything in my life.

8       What percent do you think that -- on my web site do you

9       think I might have told you about?

10  A   I haven't been out to the web site for a while. I

11       would say -- I don't know if you separated the

12       AllMyWohs part from the rest of the content on the web

13       page, but I would say up to the point where you started

14       explaining that you were God and so forth, I think that

15       was the part that you told me personally.

16  Q   Okay.

17  A   So I don't know if you want -- what else you're asking

18       but...

19       MR. ROLLER: So -- I don't know if you have any

20       idea what this suit's about, but yeah, there's a -- I

21 have this web site saying I'm God for everybody that's

22 here.

23 Q Anyways. So yeah, you knew -- so I told you I was

24 Jesus or God back a long time ago?

25 A Well, you told me that you were being watched and that

1 the government was watching you.

2 Q Yes.

3 A And you thought they were -- you know, that you  
4 explained to me that they've kind of been controlling  
5 your life. I don't think at the time that you actually  
6 told me that you were God. I read that on the web  
7 site.

8 Q Okay.

9 A I think that was after, after you left us.

10 Q I did change my philosophy. I thought I was The Second  
11 Coming, but I didn't realize I was God. So  
12 that's where I did change over time. I might come back  
13 to that, but there's something else here. Remember  
14 when I went to the hospital? Thought I got poisoned  
15 and went to the hospital?

16 A Yes.

17 Q You didn't visit me, but I -- did I speak to you at all  
18 that Bob Moore visited me? Did I tell you about that?

19 A I don't believe so.

20 Q I'm not sure if that's important or not. Anyways, did

21 I tell you who I thought was involved in this

22 poisoning?

23 A I can't recall.

24 Q Okay.

25 A It was a long time ago.

1 Q Yes, I know. It's been -- we were pretty good friends.

2 We were probably close to best friends, or at least you

3 were mine.

4 A Yup.

5 Q What distanced you from contacting me again? This is

6 the first time I've seen him -- first time I've seen

7 you.

8 A I would say --

9 Q The web site or...

10 A -- it was the topic of conversation. Whenever we got

11 together, it was always about the web site.

12 Q The people at work you mean?

13 A No. It was just the content about the web site, MyWohs

14 and whatnot, and it was just the topic of conversation

15 I didn't want to carry on with.

16 Q Oh, I see. Do you recall that AllMyWohs? Do you

17 recall when we talked about that in the apartment?

18 A Yes.

19 Q I think Nate's apartment?

20 A Yup.

21 Q Have you ever -- there's a security guy outside here.

22 Have you ever felt threatened by my presence?

23 A No. No.

24 Q Okay. Did your religious beliefs affect our

25 relationship, or it was just AllMyWohs?

1 A Religious beliefs did not affect our relationship, no.

2 Q Okay. What do you think about Jesus' powers? What do

3 you think about that whole concept? Do you believe in

4 this immaculate conception thing that's -- I told you a

5 long time ago that I'm making babies with Celine Dion

6 and stuff like that?

7 A Do I believe in that?

8 MS. WILLIAMS: Object --

9 Q No.

10 MS. WILLIAMS: Objection. Relevancy. Go ahead.

11 Q Do you remember when I told you about Celine Dion maybe

12 having my kid?

13 A Yes.

14 Q That maybe this was happening a little bit more than

15 just her?

16 A I remember you saying that, yup.

17 Q I think I maybe mentioned my neighbor, too, but

18 anyways.

19 MR. ROLLER: What was the whole objection about?

20 MS. WILLIAMS: I raised the objection of relevancy

21 because you started to ask about general religious  
22 beliefs versus your beliefs.

23 MR. ROLLER: Oh, okay. I see.

24 MS. WILLIAMS: But I think he answered the  
25 question.

1 MR. ROLLER: Okay.

2 Q Are you aware that David Copperfield -- I took him to  
3 court, found out he's got Godly powers?

4 MS. WILLIAMS: Once again I'm going to object on  
5 relevancy grounds. You can go ahead and answer.

6 A I did see that on Entertainment Tonight, yes, so I'm

9 MS. WILLIAMS: Once again objection on relevancy  
10 grounds.

11 A No.

12 Q I'm trying to avoid objections here. I'm not sure what  
13 to say here. Wow, I'm not sure what to say here. You  
14 have close ties with the other managers at GE when I  
15 was working there?

16 A Explain "close."

17 Q Well, you guys talk among each other about just other  
18 employees?

19 A To some extent, yes.

20 Q They've made me out to be a problem child in the

21 documents I received, that I was a problem child, a bad  
22 person. And I was curious if you would get word of  
23 that -- I was thinking that you should be able to get  
24 word of that and be able to relay that to me -- Chris,  
25 you need to chill out or something at work -- but I

1 never received anything from you about such behavioral  
2 problems.

3 MS. WILLIAMS: Objection. Vague and compound  
4 question.

5 A I don't know how to answer that.

6 Q Yeah, I was a nuisance at work, playing jokes all the  
7 time. The vomit gag I played on the -- at the table,  
8 fake poop on the toilet. Actually it was on a urinal.

9 Playing these games. They backfired. But did you ever
