5. Plaintiff originally filed this matter in Minnesota state court. Defendant requested removal on diversity grounds, and that motion was granted.



7. Mr. Roller has represented himself throughout this litigation, including responding to motions and discovery, filing his own motions, promulgating his own discovery and taking his own depositions.


