NOW COMES DEFENDANT, GE Medical Systems Information Technologies, Inc. ("GE") by its attorneys, Quarles & Brady LLP, moving this Court pursuant to Rules 12(b)(5) and 12(b)(6) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure for an order dismissing Plaintiff's "Supplemental" Complaint against GE in its entirety. Plaintiff's claim against GE for patent infringement fails because Plaintiff does not have a patent and because Plaintiff's alleged "godly powers" cannot be patented. Plaintiff's Complaint against GE should further be dismissed for lack of sufficient process.
